Dr. Louise Greene Henry, Ph.D., passed away peacefully at her home on March 25, 2026.

Born on April 29, 1940, in Avondale Estates, Georgia, Louise remained a proud daughter of her hometown throughout her life. She was a 1958 graduate of Avondale High School, where the foundations of her lifelong commitment to learning were laid. Louise's academic journey was a testament to her brilliance and drive.

After graduating from the University of Georgia, she earned a Master's degree from Georgia Southern University and ultimately achieved her Ph.D. from Clemson University.

Her professional life was marked by entrepreneurial success as the owner and operator of her own agricultural chemical research business, where she became a respected figure in her field.
