Sandra Norton McNure, 82, of Tifton, died on Sunday, January 25, at Maple Court Senior Care, where she thrived for nearly five years. 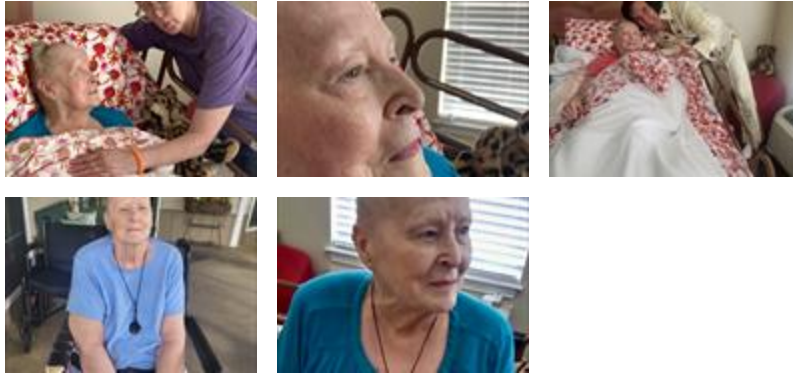
