



## Woodson Edward Crossin

January 3, 1933 - October 26, 2024

Woodson Edward Crossin, 91 years of age, from Ocilla, Georgia passed away on October 26, 2024 at his home, surrounded by his loving family.

Mr. Crossin was born on January 30, 1933 in St Louis, Missouri to the late Floyd and Anna Mae Crossin. After high school he joined the Air Force and served during the Vietnam and Korean wars. He is survived by his loving wife, Carolyn, which they just celebrated 69 years of marriage this past August, and 4 children: Paula (Mark) Troyer, Patrick
